

Work-Related Injuries

For any incident resulting in a serious or life-threatening injury, call 911 immediately for emergency medical care.

For incidents that are not serious or life-threatening, the injured employee or designee must contact their immediate supervisor and advise them of the incident. The supervisor is to inform the employee of the University Preferred Provider Agreement with OSF HealthCare. Services provided through the OSF HealthCare agreement include evaluation and treatment of work-related injuries at several locations. Employees are encouraged to treat with the OSF Occupational Health Center when open. However, employees are not required to be treated by OSF and may choose to see their own physician. Please see the hours and locations available for treatment from OSF HealthCare Facilities.
